## Session 1

Study group dynamics and the *5 Cs of Career Advancement for Women* while applying this research to skill development for equal participation as a leader.

## Session 3

**Mar. 10, 2020**  
12 PM - 4 PM

Training in Intentional Energetic Presence Fundamentals will provide the foundation to create a culture of showing up, leading, performing, connection, and optimizing energy for collaboration and satisfaction

## Session 4

**May 1, 2020**  
9 AM - 3 PM

Four Expert Female Superintendents will navigate scenarios, obstacles, and solutions for authentic learning. Ask questions about personal experiences and apply newly acquired skills for solving complex political, social, and academic concerns.
