

COMMITMENT TO RETURN TO IN-PERSON OR HYBRID LEARNING
MODEL BY MARCH 1, 2021

Ohio is preparing to distribute COVID-19 vaccines statewide in a phased approach. During Phase 1B, vaccine supply is limited, and vaccine administration will be focused on reaching critical groups, which include adults who work in schools.

For your adult school staff to be prioritized to receive the COVID-19 vaccine, you are required to return to an in-person or hybrid learning model by March 1, 2021. The certification below certifies your commitment to do so, acknowledging that complete vaccine administration may not be completed by March 1, 2021, and regardless of vaccine uptake by your staff.

In-person learning is defined as all students having the option of in-person instruction, even if schedules are somewhat adjusted. Hybrid learning is defined as a mix of in-person and remote education.

This commitment must be signed by the Superintendent or Chief Administrative Officer of the school.
Forms must be submitted by Jan. 18, 2021, to schools@odh.ohio.gov.

As the authorized representative of my school district/school, I represent our district/school is committed to returning to in-person or hybrid learning by March 1, 2021. I understand vaccines will be administered only to those who choose to receive them.
