Dr. Laura Tortorelli



Dr. Laura Tortorelli is an Associate Professor of Elementary Literacy in the Department of Teacher Education at Michigan State University. She earned her Ph.D. in Reading Education from the University of Virginia. Her scholarship examines the texts, technology, and instructional practices that support early reading acquisition in school contexts. Her work has been supported by the National Science Foundation and the International Literacy Association. She has been named an Emerging Scholar by the Reading Hall of Fame and a Jeanne Chall Visiting Researcher by the Harvard Graduate School of Education. She is currently an associate editor of *The Reading Teacher*.

Dr. Sarah Lupo is an Associate Professor at James Madison University. Dr. Lupo received her bachelor's degree from James Madison University and a Master's and Ph.D. in literacy education from the University of Virginia. Dr. Lupo has extensive teaching experience, including working as an English teacher, ESL teacher, reading specialist, and literacy coach. Dr. Lupo's work has been published in journals such as *Reading Research Quarterly*, *Review of Educational Research*, *Journal of Teacher Education*, *Journal of Adult and Adolescent Literacy*, and *Reading Teacher*. She recently published a book entitled *Teaching Disciplinary Literacy in Grades K-6: Infusing Content with Reading, Writing, and Language* (Routledge, 2021) and has a book entitled *Tackling Tough Texts: A Guide to Research-Based Scaffolding for 6-12th graders* coming out this winter (Guilford).
